- ☐ The basic eligibility criteria have been fixed for the admission of each course D. Pharmacy admission eligibility criteria in any stream from a recognized academic board got qualification from 10+2 or its equivalent board
- ☐ To enter the diploma course the board of science must pass the PCB or PCM group

### DIRECT SECOND YEAR (LATERAL ENTRY)

- □ Passed diploma course in pharmacy with (at east 45% marks at east 40% marks in case of backward class categories and persons with disability belonging to Maharashtra state only) from an All India Council of Technical Education Pho Council of India or central or state government approved Pharmacy
- institute tuition or its equivalent Any other criteria declared by appropriator authority from time to time

#### **B.PHARMACY**

- ☐ The candidate should be Indian.
- ☐ HSC or its equivalent examination with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with one of the Mathematics or Biology and obtained at least 50% marks (at least 45% marks in case of backward class categories and person with disability belonging only to Maharashtra state) in the above subjects token together
- ☐ Obtained Score in CET. Any other critertia declared by appropriate authority from time to time

#### M.PHARMACY

- ☐ A Bachelor's degree in Pharmacy (B.Pharm) from a recognized institution.
- ☐ Most programs require a minimum aggregate score (often around 50-60%) in the B.Pharm degree.
- ☐ Some universities require candidates to pass entrance exams like GPAT (in India) or other relevant assessments.
- ☐ Relevant work experience may be preferred by some institutions, especially for specialized programs.
- ☐ Some programs may ask for recommendation letters from professors or industry professionals.


